Volunteer Procedures (COVID-19 Season)

It is our heart to continue to keep our College community safe and protected. If you are unwell or exhibit any cold/flu symptoms, please stay at home. The following measures are to be put in place when volunteers are on campus.

- Upon arrival, volunteers must proceed through the Health Station at the College gate, or if volunteering later than 9am, proceed to the College Office for temperature checks.
- Volunteers must sign in and register at the office and sanitise hands.
- There may only be 1 volunteer in a withdrawal space at a time and are not to be in the regular classroom environment at this stage (this specification may change as further relaxations on restrictions come into effect).
- Volunteers are to observe the 1.5m social distancing from other adults while on campus.
- Volunteers are to assist with administrative tasks only or work 1:1 such as sight
 words or home readers with a single child at a time (whilst observing distancing
 protocols) Hands must be sanitised or washed between working with each child.

Stop the spread — coronavirus (COVID-19)

There are 5 ways we can all help stop the spread of viruses

- 1. Stay home if you're sick. If you have COVID-19 symptoms, get tested.
